

Temporary art locations for pedestals and murals



1: Side of Museum: Put in planter on the side of the museum.

2. Museum Outer Wall: This will be converted to a mural location that will showcase the theme of the art walk along with QR codes and websites to allow patrons to download online maps and descriptions of the collection.

3. Depot Gallery: This will be on the “patio” outside the gallery. This will be the starting location for many of the organized art walks, once a month.

4. Gazebo: This smaller pedestal will be on the corner of the gazebo.

5. Fountain House: Corner of Victorian Circle (West) and Victorian in place of a planter.

6. Fountain Area: Non-pedestal spot for temp art

7. 4 Ladies: Removal add 72’diameter pedestral with power same height as planters.

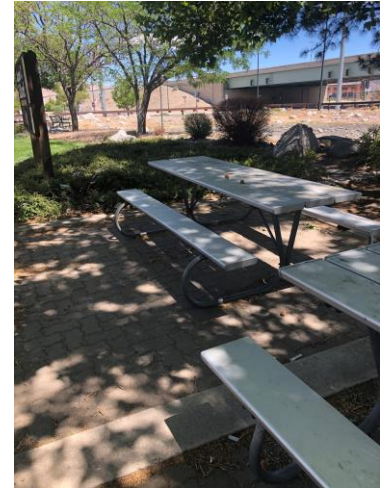
