PROJECT DESCRIPTION, SCHEDULE & BUDGET

Artwork Description

A painted mural of an approximate* size of 15' x 30', using sustainable painting materials with UV protectants and a sealer.

Scope of Work

The commissioned artist shall paint a mural that celebrates the accomplishments and contributions made by Filipino Americans to our community and the United States.

The artist shall create (2) two conceptual designs using the Project Objectives as guiding parameters. The client and Art in Public Places (APP) department will review the conceptual designs and choose (1) one design to move forward. The Final Design of the mural shall be approved by client and APP department before installation of the artwork commences.

The artist shall be responsible for choosing sustainable materials with UV protectants, preparation of the site, execution of the mural, and cleanup of the site. The artist must be present for a dedication ceremony at a date that will later be determined by the client, APP department, and based upon the artist's availability.

 orientation/sexual identity. However, preference shall be given to local artists of Asian Pacific American
 Heritage.
- Has been creating and installing public art for more than (3) three years.

Selection Criteria

- 1. Statement: Upload a statement with the following:
 - a. I am available to visit the site in person and complete the design as per the project schedule
 - b. I am over 21 years old and have been creating and installing public art for more than three years.
- 2. Resume/CV: A current and professional Resume/CV
- 3. Images: The artist will upload a minimum of 2 completed projects in 4-6 images and videos (optional). Videos are limited to 120 seconds each.
